



LETTER OF AUTHORIZATION FORM

The undersigned ("Customer") authorizes Good Energy, L.P. ("Good Energy") to obtain and review the following information from the local distribution utility, ("Data"): consumption history; billing determinants; credit information; public assistance status; and information pertaining to PSL § 33, tax status and eligibility for economic development or other incentives. This information may be shared with third party energy suppliers, and it may be used by such suppliers to determine whether they will commence and/or continue to provide energy supply service to Customer and will not be disclosed to any other third-party unless required by law. Customer's execution of this form shall constitute authorization for the release of this information to Good Energy and its suppliers. Customer hereby authorizes Good Energy to act as Customer's agent for the sole purpose of granting like authorization to third party electric and natural gas suppliers to receive Data directly from the local distribution utility company. This authorization will remain in effect for one (1) year from the date listed below or for as long as an energy supply service agreement exists between Customer and a supplier of Good Energy; provided, **Customer may rescind this authorization at any time by providing written notice to Good Energy or calling Good Energy at 1-866-955-2677.**
